

Bruges 2026 - FAQs

How many people will travel on this tour?

We have sole occupancy of an accommodation in Bruges with a capacity of 221 but we imagine a max group size of about 200 – additional accommodation options are available should numbers be higher.

What is the payment plan?

A £100 pp non-refundable deposit is required upon booking. Once numbers are finalised at the end of the spring term, a further £100 pp will be payable in April, with the balance payment then due in July.

What is the adult child ratio?

We will be working on a ratio of approx. 1 adult to every 8 children. Any individual school that has a minimum of 8 pupils sign up to the trip will be allocated 1 place at no cost.

What if we want to send more than 1 adult?

Any adults on the trip above the 1:8 ratio, will be required to pay the full tour price

Can adults have their own room?

The nature of this trip means that adults will be asked to share rooms with another adult of the same sex

What if we have fewer than 8 children sign up?

Either your school can pay for an adult to attend, or if you have just a few pupils sign up, your pupils will be allocated to the supervision of an adult from a different school. Each adult on the trip will be allocated up to 12 children to oversee and the name, contact number and any required information for this person can be provided to the school sending unsupervised children.

We have children with additional needs that would like to attend?

Any children who require specific supervision would need their carer to attend the tour and pay to attend – please note that children will be accommodated in multi-bedded, shared rooms

What is the departure point?

We will have choristers signing up from different parts of the country and until we have details of who is coming, the exact pick up points cannot be known. However, the current plan is for 4 regional pick up points across the country, with a further pick up point close to London.

Will there be a rehearsal?

Once numbers are known, the repertoire and rehearsal arrangements will be confirmed. There will be a rehearsal in location on the first evening.

Where will the group perform?

Venues depend on the final group size so cannot be confirmed at this stage. However the current plan is to have 2 main performances at venues in Northern Belgium.



If we have pupils that sign up but cannot attend, will they be refunded?

Deposits are non-refundable. If a pupil drops out of the tour after paying the final balance then we can provide documentation to support an insurance claim.

Who is responsible for what the group will perform?

Any repertoire will be overseen by the head of music at Westonbirt School, Nicola Atwell.

How do we book the trip?

Once you know how many pupils are set to come, contact us and we will send you a deposit invoice for £100 per paying passenger. We will also need you to complete a booking form, to confirm details of your group and that you have read and understood the terms and conditions of booking.

What happens once we have booked?

The tour is being managed by a specialist tour coordinator. Once you have completed the booking process, they will become your dedicated point of contact and will be in touch with the next steps.
